Horticulture 202 –ADAPTIVE LANDSCAPE & GARDEN MAINTENANCE

This is an 8 week horticulture and vocational training class. Lessons and lab activities are adapted for students with mild to moderate disabilities. Students will demonstrate basic skills used in plant identification, nursery and garden center operations, plant propagation, and sales presentation. The group will be working in the Sunflower Hill Gardens for part of the program.

Student Requirements

- ☞ Must be at least 18 years of age.
- ☞ Program is designed for individuals with mild to moderate disabilities who can participate in an indoor and outdoor classroom setting with support at a 1:4 ratio.
- ☞ Interest in pursuing employment in the horticulture, landscaping, or viticulture industry.
- ☞ Access to transportation to and from Las Positas College.
- ☞ Access to home and agency support needed for successful program participation.
