This is an eight-week short-term vocational horticulture course with lessons and lab activities that are designed for students that have difficulty in a traditional classroom setting. Students will visit examples of well-planned gardens, recognize and implement a simple garden plan, and participate in the marketing of garden plants to fulfill landscape and garden goals.

Classes will meet on Saturday in April and May, 10 am to approx. 2 pm. **The classes highlighted in red will be field trips. Transportation to be provided by Las Positas College.** Other classes will involve approx. one hour of lecture, with the remainder of the time getting hands-on lab experience on our beautiful campus, horticulture yard, and greenhouse.

The Las Positas Plant Sale on Tuesday, May 7, is an optional activity. Normally volunteers work in 2 hour shifts during the day. This activity, though not required, is a good opportunity to obtain customer service experience. The proceeds from the sale, go towards various horticultural activities, including funding for our field trips.

The final class on May 25 will include a Spring Garden Party (potluck/BBQ).
